

Hurdler named top athlete

GAINESVILLE — University of Florida women's hurdler Dorchelle Webster was named the Outstanding Female Athlete to close out the invitational division of The 47th Annual Florida Coke Classic relays.

Webster won the 400-meter hurdles, successfully defending her Relays title, in 57.80 and ran the fastest leg of Florida's record-breaking 400 meter relay.

The Lady Gators' relay team of Monifa Taylor, Kim Mitchell, Webster and Tasha Downing set the Percy Beard Track, the Florida Relays Meet and the Florida record with their NCAA qualifying time of 3:34.88.

Florida State claimed the 100 meter relays with a time of 44.69, while South Carolina State took the 200 meters at 1:37.68, and Villanova won the 800 meters with a time of 8:53.55.

Latasha Rogers of Atlantic TC leaped 21 feet to win the long jump and soared 41 feet, 11¼ inches to claim the triple jump. Holly Kelly of Florida State leaped 1.83 meters to win the high jump.

For the men, Tom Pukstys and Dion Bentley won individual events Saturday to lead Florida men's track team.
