

FSU's Metro track strategy has mixed results

It was more of a hunch than a gamble which Terry Long played in the opening events of the Metro Track & Field Championship.

And Carmellia Shivers proved to be an ace up the sleeve for an FSU women's team that really didn't need any sleight of hand.

The Lady Seminoles had 107 points after six events, 87 more than second-place Memphis State.

Shivers, normally a hurdler and high jumper, won her debut in the seven-event heptathlon. But Long's decision to put two athletes in new events proved to be a 50-50 proposition.

An FSU men's team that desperately

needed early points earned none from Larry Carr's debut in the decathlon. The pole vaulter ironically failed to place in his specialty, something that cost him a victory in the decathlon.

By night's end, FSU's 13-year domination of the men's Metro was in serious jeopardy. FSU was in fourth place after four events with 21 points. Cincinnati led with 59, followed by Virginia Tech (34) and South Carolina (31).

"The women had a super night," Long said. "The men, so far, have done less than expected. We've got a day to go, but I see it as very tough row to hoe."

"I think what we are seeing is what we've talked about for three or four years, and that is the conference is very even (on the men's side)."

Long really had nothing to lose in experimenting with Shivers and Carr. Neither was being counted on for points in the heptathlon or decathlon.

But Long's hunch was that both were strong enough to score in the meet's first-completed events.

Long looked like a genius when Shivers won the heptathlon with a school- and meet-record 5,402 points, enough to qualify her for the NCAA finals.

FSU's 1-2-3 finish of Shivers, Kim Mann and Candi Odom in that event also set the tone for a big opening night for the FSU women.

Trinette Johnson followed with a Metro record in the long jump with an effort of 20-7. Sonya Blades finished second. Shivers then came back and finished second in the high

jump behind Holly Kelly.

FSU also got first-place points out of Carrie Boyd who won the 3,000 meters in 9:46.11. Shivers competed in yet another event, finishing sixth in the shot put.

"We knew she could be tough," Long said of Shivers, a junior-college transfer in her initial season at FSU.

She was tough enough to overcome an experienced field and a bothersome knee that will be operated on in the off-season.

As for Carr, he found himself in an ideal situation when it came time for decathletes to compete in the pole vault. South Carolina's Philippe Williams, the favorite to win the decathlon, had sustained an injury.

Carr, however, faulted when he failed to clear in three attempts at 16-0 feet.

FSU men's closing kick wins the Metro again

Lady Seminoles coast to their second straight

Winner and still champion.

Florida State's reign as king of Metro Track and Field is now 14 years long, thanks to a strong finish Saturday at Mike Long Track.

Sitting in fourth place at the day's start, the FSU men's team scored 172.5 points to turn back top challenger South Carolina (136.5). Cincinnati finished third with 105.33 points.

The Seminoles have not lost a Metro meet since joining the conference in 1977.

"This really shows the character of Florida State to battle back from what appeared to be impossible odds," said head coach Terry Long, voted the Metro's most outstanding coach.

Meanwhile, the FSU women continued a modest streak of their own by winning their second straight title in dominating fashion.

FSU set 12 records in the second year of the women's meet, and increased to eight the number of the team's NCAA-qualifying events. The Lady Seminoles scored 285 points to second-place South Carolina's 79.

The record-breakers were: 400- and 1600-meter relays, Carrie Boyd (1500 meters), Tanya Granneman (discus), Kim Batten (100 hurdles, triple jump), Patrice Verdon (100 meters), Holly Kelly (high jump) and Kari Keith (javelin), Trinetta Johnson (long jump), Aundrea Lyons (400) and Carmellia Shivers (heptathlon).

And this was a women's team whose athletes admitted having difficulty preparing mentally for the meet.

One such athlete was Batten, the meet's MVP.

"At first, I had trouble getting motivated for the meet because competition was very strong, but I've gotten into it," she said. "I'm having fun."

As for the men, the fun didn't come until very late. FSU didn't take its first lead until the 12th

event. The Seminoles then placed three of the top four finishers in the 400 hurdles, and Larry Carr placed second in the pole vault.

That gave FSU a 31-point lead, and Long his first thoughts of victory.

"We needed that in the hurdles. We had fresh athletes, and South Carolina started to run out of gas," said Long, pointing to USC's Robert Brooks, the pre-meet favorite in the 400 hurdles, who finished sixth.

A stomach illness certainly didn't help Brooks or a South Carolina team hampered by injuries.

It was a much different story for FSU. Rodney Lawson, for instance, did the expected when he won the 110 high hurdles.

Rookies like Bill Rivera and Rob Circelli also had their part in the comeback.

Rivera, a former Central Florida football player, finished second in the shotput with a personal best of 53-4.

FSU was favored to win the 1,500, but that was with a healthy Jason Frank available. Frank strained a hamstring earlier in the week and was unable to finish the race. Circelli, who wasn't even scheduled to run the event, stepped in to win and give FSU badly needed first-place points.

"I did it for the team," said Circelli, a freshman.

Saturday night, the talk turned to another try for the Metro teams.

"I didn't really think it would be this time," South Carolina coach Greg Craft. "We had graduated our top athletes. Next year."

Fourteen years say that task won't be easy.
