Batten down records

FSU star hurdles NCAA outdoor mark to highlight hot meet Saturday.

After the pain and embarrassment of falling in a hurdle heat Friday, Kim Batten had one thing in mind Saturday.

"I was kind of down after falling yesterday, and all I had in my mind today was to do the best I could and try to qualify."

Batten's mission was accomplished in a big way at Saturday's final day of the FSU Relays at Mike Long Track.

With a 56.15 time in the 400-meter hurdles, Batten not only qualified for the NCAA outdoor nationals, but she also qualified for the World Track & Field Championships in Tokyo this summer. Batten's 56.15 is generally considered to be the best outdoor time in the world this season.

"It's hard to say that for sure, because you never know what everybody else has done, but put it this way: 56.15 is undoubtedly

one of the best times in the world today," said FSU coach Terry Long. "And it's a good little touch that Kim needed after falling yesterday."

Batten had fallen in the 100-meter hurdles on Friday and speculated that she'd gotten out too quickly. "I was not concentrating my best, and I think I was running a little faster than I expected to," Batten said on Saturday. "Today helped to boost my confidence."

Batten was one of many track and field athletes whose confidence was boosted by their relay's performance. Coming so early in the outdoor season and boasting a top field of teams, the FSU Relays proved a good diagnostic tool for many athletes.

"Today I felt like I needed to go out and see where I really am in my training," said Florida A&M hurdler David Lucas. I've been

progressing each meet, and I'm getting better."

Lucas has gotten better so far this season to the tune of first place in the open division 400-meter hurdles race on Saturday, running a time of 51.5. As he crossed the finish line, though, he punched his open palm with a fist.

"I hit that last hurdle, and coming off that last one determines my time," Lucas said. "I felt real good about the race until that last hurdle. That could take .4 or .5 seconds off your time, and in track, that's a lot of time."

A lot of time is exactly what it didn't take for the so-called "glamour" events of the meet. The Division I 100-meter dash final took only 10.47 for LSU's Jason Sanders. He narrowly beat Tommy Walker of Tennessee (10.54) and FSU's Corey Fuller (10.56), who trotted back to the finish line saying only, "We'll see them again."

A star for the FSU men was

Kelsey Nash, who ran with all three of the men's winning relay teams. He's just a freshman.

And the women's 400-meter relay event took less than a minute for the LSU women's team of Cheryl Taplin, Dahlia Duhaney, Dawn Bolles and Esther Jones to set an FSU Relays record of 44.28. The FSU team of Aundrea Lyons, Batten, Patrice Verdun and Sheryl Covington finished second with a time of 45.59.

But the FSU women won the 1600-meter relay, beating LSU with a time of 3:40.72. That team was Kim Mann, Andy Lyons, Sheryl Covington and Batten. Batten anchored a 52.1 to bring the team from behind.

"Definitely, LSU's a top national women's team," Batten said of the victors. "You can't expect anything but the best when they're here to compete."

And about finishing second to them? "They've got my respect, but I won't back down," Batten said.

The exceptional field of this year's FSU Relays led Long to comment, "What a good meet. Having LSU here and Florida and Tennessee is great. When teams of that quality come to Tallahassee, it can only be good for the sport."
