Track team wins quad meet

BATON ROUGE, La. — The FSU men's track team edged past Louisiana State Sunday to win a quad meet and remain undefeated this season, while the women's team finished second behind LSU, the defending nastional champion.

The Seminole men (10-0) scored 61 points. LSU finished with 59, Texas-El Paso with 45 and Texas Southern with 28.

Jeff Gray became a provisional qualifier for national competition with his pole vault height of 17' 6" and Kelsey Nash won the triple jump with a leap of 48' 2".

The Lady Seminoles (8-2) scored 41 points and finished a distant second behind LSU's 84 total. Texas Southern finished third with 21 and UTEP fourth at 14.

Four women set meet records: Kim Batten in the 400 IH with a time of 56.89, Angela Harris in the 800 meters with a time of 2:13.66, Holly Kelley with a high jump of 5' 8" and Carrie Boyd with a time of 4:23.38 in the 1500 meter run.
