Clemson sweeps in track

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. — Clemson's men won their fourth straight ACC indoor track title and the Tiger women ended North Carolina's four-year winning streak Saturday at East Tennessee State.

The Clemson men had 136 points, followed by North Carolina with 112. N.C. State finished third with 68. Florida State had 61, Wake Forest 42, Georgia Tech 35, Virginia 33 and Maryland 9.

In women's competition, Clemson finished with 107 points. North Carolina had 95, Virginia 71, Georgia Tech 57, Florida State 52, N.C. State 33, Maryland 12 and Wake Forest 7. Clemson used its strength in the sprints and middle distance events to win the men's title. Michael Green won the 55 meters in 6.15 seconds and Larry Ryans lead a 1-3-4 showing in the 55-meter hurdles with a meet-record 7.12 seconds. Teammate Cormac Finnerty swept the mile (4:03.72) and 3,000-meter run (8:16.73).

North Carolina's Reggie Harris was named the men's MVP after a record-breaking day. Harris won the 200 in 20.60 seconds and 400 in 45.94 seconds. He qualified for the NCAA championships in both events.

Kim Graham, who shared the women's MVP award, led the Clemson women to victory. She ran the 55 meters in 6.91 seconds and the 200 in a meet-record 23.59 seconds. The Tigers also won the 55-meter hurdles with Monique Everett finishing in 7.74 seconds and the women's mile with Karen Hartmann finishing in 4:44.49.

Green shared MVP honors with Marchelle Payne of Maryland, who bounded a meet record 43 feet, 9¼ inches in the triple jump.

North Carolina's Rebecca Russell ran the 800 in a meet record 2:06.62, Nelrae Pasha of Georgia Tech won the 400 in 53.43 seconds and Florida State's Jeff Bray cleared 17 feet, 10½ inches in the pole vault.
