

FSU women fall to Tampa

The Florida State women's basketball team lost a 17-point lead, finally falling 68-65 to the University of Tampa here Saturday night.

Cherry Rivers and Ann Collins led the Seminoles with 21 and 20 points, in that order. FSU led at the half, 34-28. The women's team comes home Tuesday night to play Albany State.

Tampa, 68-65

The University of Tampa, down by 10 points at the half, came roaring back in the final minutes of the game Saturday night, to defeat Florida State 68-65 in women's basketball at Howell Gym.

Vivian Pawson put the Spartans, 5-3, ahead for good, 67-65, with a field

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goal at the one-minute mark, as the 125 people in attendance, most of them Tampa fans, cheered wildly.

The loss dropped FSU to 5-3.
