ROCK HILL, S.C. — The Florida State women's basketball team had rough going in the Winthrop College Invitational and find themselves out of the tournament.

Thursday night the Lady Seminoles lost to host Winthrop College, 71-63. Freshman Martha Lappe was the leading scorer for FSU with 17 points. Jackie Arnold, Laine Lasseter, and Rose Harper added 10 apiece.

Then on Friday, FSU lost to Appalachian State, 89-83. Lasseter scored 22 points for the Lady 'Noles. Darlene Shannon added 13, Lappe had 12 and Harper scored 10 points.
