

Mississippi College routes Lady Seminole cagers 90-50

Mississippi College for Women charged to a 43-21 halftime bulge and then coasted to a 90-50 victory over the Lady Seminoles Monday night at Tully Gym.

Rowanna Pope rolled up 24 points to lead Mississippi College. Karen Cox had 19 and Lisa Bridgeman added 16 for the winners who improved their record to 10-2.

For FSU, now 5-9, Diane Blaydes was high with 13 points. Playing in her first game since recovering from foot surgery, Laine Lasseter scored nine points. Lasseter, a 6-foot sophomore, was FSU's leading scorer and rebounder a year ago.
