

Lady 'Noles win second straight

SANFORD — Florida State's Lady Seminoles withstood a strong second half charge by McNeese State Friday night for a 69-62 victory in first round action of the Ladies Sunshine Classic. The Lady 'Noles will meet Valdosta State, 83-82 upset winners over Georgia, in the finale tonight at 9.

The victory, FSU's second in as many starts, was achieved by a strong showing in the first half. Behind the quick floor game and shooting of Sue Galkanas and Lisa Foglio, the Lady 'Noles pushed to a 31-18 halftime lead. In one stretch in the first half, McNeese failed to score for eight minutes.

In the second half the Lady 'Noles went into the cooler for three minutes without a bucket and McNeese narrowed the Seminole edge to 44-40 with 10:40 left in the game. In that stretch, the McNeese girls tallied 10 straight points without a Seminole reply.

With 1:28 left in the game and the FSU girls in front 63-60, Foglio iced the game with six straight points.

McNeese's Pat Jean was top scorer in the game with 20, while Galkanas had 18 and Foglio 16 to lead the Lady Seminoles.
