Lady Seminoles win tournament

SANFORD — The Florida State women's basketball team won the Lady Sunshine Classic Saturday by beating Valdosta State 82-69 in the final.

It was the first tournament win at FSU for third-year coach Janice Dykehouse and raised the Lady Seminoles' record to 3-0.

Sophomore Sue Galkantas had 19 points in the first half, finished with 26 and was named MVP in the tourney. Galkantas and senior Lisa Foglio, who had 18 points, were named to the all-tournament team. FSU's LeeVayn Oliver finished with 12 points.

The game was tied many times in the first half until Valdosta took the lead at 10:51. FSU retook the lead 20-19 at 9:02 on a jump shot by Sunnie O'Neal and had a 44-39 halftime lead.

The Lady Seminoles will play in Purdue Boilermaker Classic next weekend.
