

Lady 'Noles capture first-round tourney win

WEST LAFAYETTE, Ind. — Sue Galkantas, with her 30-point performance Friday, moved into sixth place on the Florida State all-time scoring list with 743 points as she led the Lady Seminole basketball team to an 80-66 victory over Kent State in the first round of the Purdue Boilermaker Classic.

The game also marked the eighth time Galkantas has scored 30 points in a game for Florida State, which led by as much as 18 points in the contest. Lisa Foglio scored 14 points.

Vonnie Beachy led Kent State with 25 points.

The Lady Seminoles will play either Purdue or Wayne State for the championship at 6 p.m. tonight.
