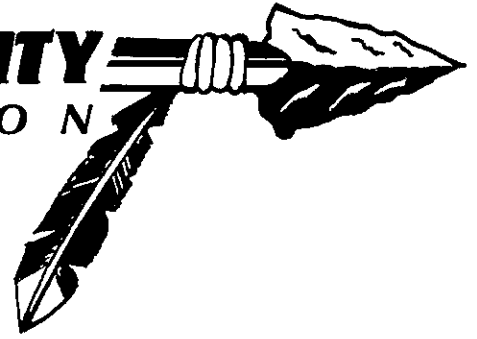

FLORIDA STATE ROLLS OVER FAMU

December 10, 1995

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. -- Sophomore forward Lysa Moorefield, of Altamonte Springs, scored a career-high 28 points to lead the Florida State Lady Seminole basketball team to a 90-65 victory over cross-town rival Florida A&M at the Leon County Civic Center tonight. With the win, the Lady Seminoles, who shot .594 for the game, including an amazing .708 in the second half, improves to 3-2 while FAMU falls to 3-4 on the young season.

The Lady Seminoles took a five-point lead (43-38) into the lockerroom and despite threats early in the second half, FAMU would never regain the lead in the game. The Rattlerettes were held to just three points in the last 6 1/2 minutes as Florida State went on a 16-3 run.

Including Moorefield's game-high 28 points, five FSU players scored in double figures. Latrice McLin scored 14, Jen Robinson had a career-high 13 and Kristy White (career highs 12 points and 11 rebounds) and Carla Williams (10 points, 11 rebounds) recorded "double-doubles." It's the first career "double-double" for White, while it marks Williams' eighth overall and third this season. Robinson's game-high 10 assists was a career-high for the freshman point guard.

For FAMU, Shantell Jackson led the way with 21 points and five rebounds.

Florida State's next action will be Sunday, Dec. 10 as the Tribe welcomes Tennessee-Chattanooga to Tully Gym for a 2 p.m. showdown.
