

Lady Seminoles run second

NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J. — Florida State's women's cross country team, with five of its runners finishing in the top 18, came in second in the 17-team Rutgers Invitational Saturday.

Maryland, a national power, won the meet with 47 points. The Lady Seminoles had 61 points. Finishing third was Princeton with 87 points.

Top runner for FSU was Darien Andreu who finished eighth in a field of 117 runners in a time of 18:01. Bridget Leddy of Villanova was the winner in 17:38.

Other Lady Seminole runners included Kathy Moore, ninth (18:02); Mary Banks, 12th, (18:05); Gale Grant, 14th, (18:08); and Nancy Jaquish, 18th, (18:19).
