

N.C. State wins in cross-country

North Carolina State's cross-country team breezed to an easy victory in the Lady Seminole Invitational at the Florida State golf course Saturday.

The Wolfpack, rated as the top women's cross-country team in the country, had the top three finishers and

finished with 23 points. California-Berkley was second with 60.

Florida State's team placed fifth with 104 points.

North Carolina State's Julie Shea won the individual competition with a time of 16:40. Florida State's top finisher was Kathy Moore, who finished 16th with a time of 18:23.
