

Coed's Third 74 Wins AIAW Golf

SAN DIEGO — Mary Budke of Oregon State fired a final round 74 to capture the Assn. of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women national title by four strokes here Saturday.

Miss Budke, who finished with a four-round total of 301, was never seriously challenged for the individual title. Marga Stubblefield of the University of Hawaii finished second at 305 while Martha Jones of Rollins College ended at 307.

Host San Diego State walked off with two-woman team honors at 625 followed by UCLA at 626. Rollins College took the four-woman team title with a 1281 score while the University of

Miami finished second at 1287.

University of New Mexico coed Alex Reinhardt finished well back in the pack after a good start over two rounds. Reinhardt fired 78-76-84-80 for a 318 total. Budke had scores of 78-74-74-74. Another New Mexico coed, Maxann Schwartz fired her fourth 80-plus round — an 87 — to finish at 337.
