FSU women finish 10th as FIU rules golf match

ATHENS, Ga. (AP) — Florida International left no doubt as to the championship of the women's Southern Intercollegiate Championship in Sunday's final round, wrapping up the title with 917 points.

Florida was a distant second with 949, while Georgia was in third place at 961, Ohio finished fourth with 962 points and Tulsa was fifth with a total of 967. Florida State was 10th at 1,000.

Brendo Rego of Florida International finished with a 72 in the final round of the 54-hole tournament, for a total of 224, while second low scorer was Terri Moody of Georgia with 73 for the final round and a total of 226.

Third was Becky Pearson of Florida Internationl at 227, and fourth was Mary Duggan, also of Florida International, with 228.

The final round saw two holes-inone, one by Karen Escott of Michigan State on the No. 8 of 156 yards, and Kathy Graham of North Carolina on the 175-yard No. 3 hole.
