

Lady Seminoles lead golf tourney

AUBURN, Ala. — The Florida State women's golf team widened its lead to 28 points through two rounds of play in a tournament with Auburn and Troy State.

Led by Michelle Guilbault, who shot a course record score of 69 Monday, the Lady Seminoles pulled ahead of Auburn 586 to 614. Troy State trailed with 710.

In two rounds, Guilbault had scores of 73-69; Marla Anderson, 72-71; and Lisa Young, 74-75.

The final round will be played today.

FSU women win golf tourney

AUBURN, Ala. — Florida State's woman's golf team finished first Tuesday in the Auburn Invitational.

The FSU women had an 892 total, with rounds of 293-293-306. Auburn was second with a 914 total, while Troy State was third at 1,070.

FSU's Michele Guilbault was the top individual golfer in the tournament, with a 218 score. Other FSU scores included Marla Anderson, 221, Lisa Young, 223, Nancy Scranton, 230, and Berst, 245.

Anderson was in a playoff for second, but lost to an Auburn player.

The next FSU match is at New Port Richey Dec. 8-11, in the Beacon Woods Invitational.
