

FSU third in Lady Gator golf

GAINESVILLE — Florida State's women's golf team is in third place after Friday's first day of play in the Lady Gator Invitational.

Southern Methodist leads with a 293 total, followed by Miami (298), Florida State (300), Oklahoma State (303) and Texas A&M (305).

For the Lady Seminoles, Lisa Young and Barbara Bunkowski each shot a 73. Michele Guilbeulb had a 77, Jane Geddes a 77 and Marla Anderson a 78.

FSU women golfers take first

GAINESVILLE — The FSU women's golf team won its second big tournament of the year during the weekend at the Lady Gator Invitational.

Lady Seminole Lisa Young fired a three-day total of 214 to take the individual honors as FSU came in with an 889 team total, three strokes better than second-place Miami.

Texas and SMU were tied for third at 905, and Florida came in fifth at 908. After Young, Jane Geddes finished fifth with a 222 total, Barb Bunkowski took seventh at 223. Finishing out of the Top Ten, were FSU's Marla Anderson at 231 and Michelle Guileault at 234.

Women golfers tied for lead

GAINESVILLE — The FSU women's golf team surged into a tie for the lead of the Lady Gator Classic Saturday with several record-breaking performances.

Lady Seminoles Lisa Young and Jan Geddes both shot 70s to set a tournament record for the best pairing score. FSU's total score of 592 was good enough to tie Miami and the Lady Seminoles' second-round score of 292 was also the lowest in tournament history.

Young has the individual lead with a total of 143. Geddes is in fourth with a 147 total. Marla Anderson, Michelle Gilbault and Barbara Bunkowski all had 76s. the third and final round started this morning.
