FSU women golfers soar to first

AUSTIN, Tex. — The Florida State women's golf team moved into first place Saturday after two rounds of the Betsy Rawls Invitational.

Standing uecond after Friday's first-round action with a 311 total, FSU's four-woman team shot a 306 round Saturday to move three strokes ahead of second-place Texas A&M at 620.

Texas Christian is in third place with a 622 total, followed by Texas and Arizona State at 625. Florida stands 16th in the 21-team field.

The tournament's individual leader is Lisa Kluver of Arizona State with a 148 total. FSU's Maria Anderson is in fourth place with a two-round total of 151, followed by teammate Lisa Young with a 152.

Anderson joined two members of the Texas A&M squad in shooting the tournament's low round Saturday. Anderson, Shirley Furlong and Monica Welsh shot 73s on the par-72 Great Hills Country Club course.
