DAY 3

TALLAHASSEE--The 18th Annual Lady Seminole Invitational held at the Seminole Golf Course ended with Duke University in first place with a three round total of 886. Sophomore Stephanie Sparks of Duke lead the entire tournament by shooting 69-69-71 for a new tournament record 209, breaking a seven year record by four strokes held by Jenny Lidback of LSU and Pam Elders of Alabama. Placing second individually was Tonya Blosser, also of Duke, who shot 75-75-67 for 217. Rounding out the team top five is: University of South Florida with 918, University of Central Florida with 924, Louisiana State University with 929, and Florida State and Florida International tied for fifth with 938.

Individually, the highest finish for the Lady Seminoles was Kelly Pittman. A senior from Vidalia, Georgia, Pittman shot 77-70-75 for 222 and a tie for fourth. Other finishers for the Lady Seminoles were: Kate Burton, freshman, tied for 14th with 82-76-74 for 232; Tiffany Faucette, junior, tied for 28th with 79-80-79 for 238; Mabel P. del Pobil, freshman, tied for 48th with 81-80-85 for 246; and Sarah Stimac, sophomore walk-on, in 61st with 90-85-85 for 260. Individually, senior Carrie Wallace finished 98-87-92 for 277 and 71st place.

***NEW TOURNAMENT RECORD

DAY 1

In the first day of competition in the 18th annual Lady Seminole Golf Invitational, Duke University jumped out to an early lead with a 291 first round total. The Blue Devils built a sixteen stroke lead over second place Florida International.

Florida State shot a 319 to place eighth for the day. The Lady Seminoles started four first time players on the par 72 course. FSU was lead by senior Kelly Pittman, of Vidalia, GA who shot a 77, the lowest score on the team, placing 13th overall. Tiffany Faucette, a junior out of Seabreeze, FL, shot a 79 to place in the tournament's top 25.

The tournament leader is Duke University sophomore, Stephanie Sparks who shot a 69. Teammate Jamie Koizumi shot a blistering tournament best 35 on the first nine to secure a second place position with a 71.

Rounding out the top five are: Dunn, FIU (74); Immekus, UNC-Wilmington (74); and Wood, Mississippi State (74).

The second round of the tournament begins today at noon at the Seminole Golf Course. Florida State tee time is 1:30pm.

Coaches Quotes:

Debbie Dillman (FSU Coach):

"They played like four players who were competing in their first collegiate round. They were nervous very early and it showed. They started to settle down as the round went on and I expect them to do better the next two days."

Dan Gierlach (USF Coach):

"A respectable first round. Duke played so well that it made the rest of the field look like they played poorly. I expect us to play better each day. We didn't play our last four holes well, and I think the whole field scores will be better tomorrow. The weather and the course were conducive to good scores. I'm hoping for a top three finish, that was our goal coming in and I think we can get that."

DAY 2

TALLAHASSEE-- On the second day of the Lady Seminole Invitational kept the Duke Blue Devils in first place with a two round total of 589. Sophomore Stephanie Sparks of Duke University continues to hold her first place spot with two rounds of 69's. Her two day total is 138, nine strokes ahead of second place FSU finisher, Kelly Pittman. Rounding out the top five spots are: Wood (Miss. St.) 74-74=148, in third place; and tied for fourth are Blosser (Duke) who shot 75-75, Coats (LSU) who 77-73, and Kozumi (Duke) who shot 71-79 all for 150.

The Lady Seminole squad improved their eighth place first day finish by moving into a tie with Louisiana State University for third. The Lady Seminoles shot a 306 yesterday, 13 strokes ahead of their first round score, with the help of senior Kelly Pittman's second round, two-under par 70. Other Lady Seminole scores: Kate Burton in 25th with 158, Tiffany Faucette in 29th with 159, Mabel P. del Pobil in 33rd with 161, Sarah Stimac in 63rd with 175. Carrie Wallace, playing as an individual for the Lady Seminoles, finished in 71st with 185.

The tee times for the tournament today will be a 8:00 am. The Lady Seminoles will be teeing off at 8:45 am at the Seminole Golf Course in Tallahassee.
