FLORIDA STATE SHUTS OUT JACKSONVILLE STATE 4-0

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- The Florida State women's soccer team (10-4-1) shut out the Jacksonville State Lady Gamecocks (6-10-1) 4-0 this cold evening in front of 211 shivering fans at the Seminole Intramural Soccer Complex. The win was FSU's seventh shut out of the season and remain perfect against non-ACC opponents.


Leading the way for the Seminoles was senior midfielder Kelley Poole, who put in the game-winning goal at the 11-minute mark of the first half. The lone goal of the first half was Poole's twelfth of the season and her fifth game winner. She is in sole posession of the team lead after distancing herself from freshman midfielder Kasey McCall by one point. Sophomore sweeper and 1995 Team MVP Janine Lavoie added the assist, her first offensive scoring point of the season.

In a 20 minute time frame during the second half three more Seminoles added goals.

At the 55-minute mark senior defender Nicole Sedgwick took a McCall pass from six yards out. McCall leads the team with six assists and is second overall in scoring.


Sophomore forward Alex Osorio added her third goal of the season on a penalty kick after JSU was flagged for a hand-ball. Two minutes later, at the 76-minute mark, Sophomore forward Jessica Driscoll chipped in a cross pass from the right sideline by Osorio.

FSU takes on nationally-ranked Clemson Sunday, October 20th at 2 p.m.




OPPONENT: Jacksonuille State
