LADY SEMINOLES EARN FIRST WIN OVER APPALACHIAN STATE

BOONE, NC -- The Florida State Lady Seminoles (1-1-0) earn their first victory of the 1997 season with a 2-0 shut out over Appalachian State (0-1-0) Sunday afternoon at Kidd Brewer Stadium.

Midfielder Erin Grimsley notched the first goal of the game at the 26:44 off a pass from forward Janna Walkup to take a 1-0 lead. Walkup would later notch the game's final goal as she found the back of the net off a Alex Osorio pass at the 88:21 mark of the second half, sealing the 2-0 Seminole victory. Grimsley's first half score marked her second straight in as many games, while Osorio's assist to Walkup also gives her two in as many contests.

Seminole goalkeeper Melissa Juhl notched two saves, while the FSU defense held the Mountaineers to just three shots. ASU keeper Leslie Beckman recorded four saves, while the ASU defense held Seminole offense to just eight total shots.

Florida State Edges Appalachian Women In Season Opener

BOONE, N.C. — Florida State notched their first win of the 1997 season as they shutout Appalachian State 2-0 Sunday afternoon in Kidd Brewer Stadium. The win improved the Seminoles record to 1-1, while the Mountaineers fell to 0-1 on the season.

Florida State Sophomore midfielder Erin Grimsley netted the first goal of the afternoon at the 26:44 mark, off a pass from Janna Walkup, to give the Seminoles an early 1-0 lead. Walkup would later put the game out of reach, as she found the back of the net at the 88:21 mark, sealing a 2-0 victory for the Seminoles.

Appalachian played solid defense throughout the game. The Mountaineer back field limited the Seminoles to just one second-half shot on goal. Appalachian managed three shots in the contest. Florida State goalkeeper Melissa Juhl recorded two saves while Mountaineer goalie Leslie Beckman recorded four saves in the match.

"I think we played excellent today," Appalachian head coach Ben Popoola remarked after the game. "We stuck to our game plan and had a few chances to make some things happen towards the end. Hopefully we learned from this and can apply it to our game with Liberty next week."

Sunday's contest marked the first for Popoola as head coach of the Appalachian women's soccer program.

The Mountaineers travel to Liberty, Sat. Sept.6 at 7 p.m., as they take on the Flames. Appalachian returns to Kidd Brewer Stadium, Fri. Sept.19 at 7:30 p.m., as they host Georgia Southern.
