FSU SETBACK BY NO. 1 CAROLINA 9-0

CHAPEL HILL, NC -- The Florida State women's soccer team (2-2, 0-2 in the ACC) was dealt a setback Sunday afternoon as the North Carolina Tar Heels, winners of 14 national championships, defeated the Seminoles 9-0 in front of 2,456 at Fetzer Field.

FSU was only able to get off two shots on goal the entire game by team leader Erin Grimsley and true freshman Sally Shelgren as compared to UNC's 34 shots on goal.

All-ACC goalkeeper Melissa Juhl tallied six saves on the day.

UNC's Raven McDonald headed in the eventual game-winning goal at the 9:47 mark off of a pass by All-ACC player Laurie Schwoy.

CHAPEL HILL, N.C.-- Ten players got into the scoring column Sunday afternoon as the top-ranked University of North Carolina women's soccer team opened its 1997 Atlantic Coast Conference season with a 9-0 victory Florida State before a crowd of 2,456 fans at Fetzer Field.

Sophomore midfielder Laurie Schwoy led the way for the Tar Heels by tallying two goals and one assist as UNC had eight different goal scorers and six different players contributing assists.

Carolina got all the offense it needed at the 9:47 mark when freshman forward Raven McDonald scored off assists by Tiffany Roberts and Schwoy. Schwoy scored her first goal just 2:49 later off another assist by Roberts. Meredith Florance, Lindsay Stoecker and Lorrie Fair went on to add goals before halftime as Carolina led at the break 5-0.

Cindy Parlow got her first goal of the year for the Tar Heels at the 55:21 mark and Robin Confer, Schwoy and Nel Fettig added goals later in play to make the final 9-0.

Carolina outshot FSU 31-2. Melissa Juhl had six saves for the Seminoles.

UNC is now 4-0 overall and 1-0 in the ACC. FSU is 2-2 overall and 0-2 in the ACC. The Tar Heels' next match is versus Virginia Commonwealth this coming Friday at 7 p.m. at Fetzer Field.
