

FSU women whip JU 20-0 and 6-0

JACKSONVILLE—The Florida State womens softball team swamped Jacksonville University in a pair of games Wednesday, 20-0 and 6-0, to up its record to 15-2 on the season.

The Seminoles collected 16 hits in the first game while Robin Willy hurled a three-hitter. Willy also collected two hits, as did teammates Gayle Lee, Cathy Norton and Barbara Harris. Bonnie Morgan went 4-for-4 for the Seminoles. In the second game, Cheryle Cordes pitched a two-hitter while Seminoles Dianne Lawrence (2-for-2), Willy (1-for-1) and Norton (1-for-1) had perfect days at the plate.

Next on the Seminoles' schedule is the South Florida Invitational Tournament March 31 and April 1. FSU is seeded third and plays Florida in the first round of the double elimination event at 9 a.m. Friday morning.
