

## FSU women sweep a pair

TAMPA — The Florida State women's softball team swept a pair of games Friday afternoon here in the South Florida Invitational. The Seminoles, now 17-2 on the year, are only two victories away from winning the tournament title. They play again at 11 a.m. this morning against Flagler.
