

FSU women sweep Florida

The Florida State women's softball team ran its record to 19-4 with a doubleheader sweep of Florida here Monday. A dramatic final-inning home run by Cathy Norton gave the first game to the Seminoles 1-0 while the second game was a 4-1 FSU victory.

Norton led off the bottom of the seventh inning for FSU with the score deadlocked at 0-0. Norton proceeded to slam the ball in the left-center gap for a clean homer. In the second game, FSU jumped in front early with a pair of second-inning runs and never trailed.

Robin Wiley was the winning pitcher in both contests, allowing just one run in 14 innings on the mound. In the second tilt, Debbie Billington supplied outstanding defense and offense while Cherly Cordes had a two-run triple and Mary Sheuehler added two hits.

The Seminoles play again today at Lake City Community College. FSU will play a doubleheader against the defending state junior college champion starting at 2:30 p.m.
