

FSU women lose again in softball

The Florida State women's softball team did the unexpected for the second day in a row Friday — it lost while hosting the regional tournament. But the Seminoles are still in the running as the tourney has advanced to the double elimination stage. FSU lost one game Thursday in the round-robin qualifying and split its two Friday afternoon double-elimination games.

South Florida was the culprit Friday, downing FSU 6-3 after the Seminoles had dropped Florida

International 3-0 earlier in the morning and Delta State 5-2 in the afternoon. FSU and USF each had nine hits, but the visitors came out on top. In FSU's first game Friday, it rode the bat of Cathy Norton and Mary Schuehler (two hits each). In FSU's second game, the Seminoles belted 14 hits as Norton, Colleen Buckley and Gayle Lee had three apiece.

The tournament continues today at Messer Field with the probably championship game taking place at 2:30 p.m.
