

## FSU, Rattlerettes rough up Chipola

Florida State's Lady Seminole softball team clobbered Chipola Junior College Monday, sweeping a doubleheader 15-1 and 16-1.

Later Monday, Florida A&M's Rattlerettes split a doubleheader with Chipola, winning 9-1 before losing 6-4.

FSU is 42-7 and will enter this weekend's state tournament in Tampa as the No. 1 seed.

FSU had 15 hits in the first game and 17 in the second. Natalie Drouin's two-run homer in the first inning of the opener provided all the runs FSU needed. Shortstop Darby Cottle added a solo homer in fifth.

Toni Robinette kicked off the second game with another two-run homer. Drouin went four-for-four with a pair of runs batted in. Kelly Tillman, three-for-four, chipped in three RBI.

Two seniors, catcher Venus Ross and third baseman Carol O'Domski, played their final game at home. Ross, last year's MVP, went three-for-three in the opener and sat out the second game. O'Domski played both games and scored six runs while going four-for-seven.

In Florida A&M's first game, Renae Nottage had three hits, Karen Jones had two hits, including a home run, and Roslyn Thomas and Marcia Cone had two hits. Lisa Sipp collected two runs batted in.

In the second game, Jones and Bertha Browning went two-for-three and Browning had a two-run home run.

The Rattlerettes take a 20-17 record to the state tournament.
