

Lady Seminoles take two

SAVANNAH, Ga., — Top-seeded Florida State rolled through the opening day of the AIAW Region III softball tournament Friday.

The Lady Seminoles stopped Livingstone (Ala.) State 15-2 in six innings in their opener and came back to trounce Georgia Southern 16-0 in five innings. Both games were stopped early because of the 10-run rule.

FSU meets second-seeded South Florida today at 11 a.m. in the double-elimination tournament. The winner advances to the championship round and will need only one victory to take the tournament.

Lead-off hitter Carol O'Domski went four-for-four and scored four runs in FSU's win against Livingstone State. Natalie Drouin added a four-for-four performance and had two RBI. FSU put the game away with an five-run sixth inning. Toni Robinette had the big hit in the inning a two-run double.

Susan Painter, who also pitched the opener, recorded the Lady Seminoles' 22nd shutout of the season in the second game. FSU put together five hits to score eight runs in the fourth inning, and Nancy Anderson completed the rout with a three-run homer in the fifth.
