

FSU women win tourney

RALEIGH, N.C. — Florida State's softball team defeated Northern Kentucky 8-0 to win the championship of the North Carolina State Invitational Saturday.

The Lady Seminoles, 37-8, beat host N.C. State 6-0 in the finals of the winners' bracket behind the hitting of Sandy Williams, who had two hits and drove in three runs, and Toney Donaldson, who belted two hits.

FSU's Susan Painter was named MVP of the tournament and was also named to the all-tournament team, along with teammates Donaldson, Williams, Jan Sikes, Darby Cottle and Natalie Drouin. The Lady Seminoles didn't allow any runs to be scored against them during the tournament.

Florida State plays Chipola Junior College in a double-header at 4 p.m. Wednesday at FSU's Stadium Field.
