

## FSU women win tourney again

RALEIGH, N.C. — The Florida State softball team added two more victories Saturday to sweep undefeated to the championship of the North Carolina State Invitational. It was the third year in a row that the Lady Seminoles, the defending national slow-pitch champions, have won this tournament.

Saturday, FSU defeated Cleveland State 5-3, and beat Northern Kentucky 17-1 in the championship game.

FSU shortstop Darby Cottle, who was 10 for 16 at the plate during the tournament, was named the tournament's MVP. She also was one of seven Lady Seminoles to make the 12-player all-tournament team. Other FSU players chosen for that team were pitcher Susan Painter, first baseman LeeAnn Harrell, third baseman Carla Long, and outfielders Teresa Collins, Cricket Olafson, and Sunnie O'Neal.

FSU, 35-5, will play its final home games Monday, facing Jacksonville in a doubleheader that begins at 3:30 p.m. on Lady Seminole Field. Wednesday, the Lady Seminoles will play a doubleheader at Florida A&M.
