FSU sweeps FAMU

The Florida State Lady Seminoles used the big inning to sweep a double-header from Florida A&M 10-0 and 12-3 Wednesday at the FAMU soft-ball complex.

FSU erupted for four runs in the sixth inning of the first game to seal the win. Until then, the Lady Seminoles were nursing the 1-0 lead they

posted in the first inning.

Florida A&M grabbed a 2-0 lead in the second game with two first-inning runs. FSU cut the Rattlerette lead to 2-1 in the same inning and then erupted for seven runs in the fifth, by bunching four hits around three FAMU errors.

The losses drop FAMU's record to 17-24; FSU is 39-6. The Rattlerettes will play at Columbus College in Columbus, Ga., today, while Florida State plays at Lake City Community College today.
