

FSU softball team cruises to tourney title

LYNCHBURG, Va. — Florida State shut out Penn State 5-0 to win the Lady Flame Invitational softball tournament on Saturday.

Shelley Berube pitched a two-hitter in the final. Offensively, Amy Snider went 2 for 3 with a pair of doubles and 4 RBIs.

Prior to that game, FSU downed North Carolina 3-1 behind Tina Kyler's nine-strikeout, four-hit pitching. Teresa Collins was 2 for 3 with a home run.

Lady Seminoles Kyler and Collins were selected to the all-tournament team.

Florida State, 37-5-2, plays a doubleheader at Florida A&M on Tuesday at 5 p.m.
