TALLAHASSEE--Junior pitcher Julie Larsen pitched a two-hit shutout and scored the winning run on an error as the ^{ninth-ranked} Florida State Lady Seminoles defeated the Adelphi Panthers 1-0 ^{in 9 innings} in the first game of a best of three NCAA Regional playoff game at Lady Seminole Field Friday night.

The Lady Seminoles and Adelphi were knotted in a scoreless pitchers duel between Larsen (24-7) and Kris Peterson (20-6) through 8 2/3 innings when Larsen singled past Adelphi second baseman Doreen Lumbra. Advancing to second on a wild pitch, Larsen scored when shortstop Bella Totino threw wildly past first base on a grounder by FSU designated player Debbie DeJohn. Larsen scored from second on the error giving Florida State its first victory in post-season play and raising its record to 49-12 on the season. Adelphi drops to 31-10-1.

Larsen in pitching her 16th shutout of the season struck out eight and walked two while holding Adelphi hitless through five and two-thirds innings.

Florida State missed two earlier scoring chances in the second inning when catcher Carolyn Fiero led off the bottom half of the inning with a double. After advancing to third on a bunt attempt by Jill Bellamy, she tried to score when Dee Dee Coyne's ^{first} throw went wild to ~~third~~. Fiero was tagged out at home when second baseman Lumbra, backing up first base, threw home in time for the putout. In the bottom of the eighth, ^{first} baseman Lori Crouse drew a two-out walk. Once again Fiero doubled to right field. Coach JoAnne Graf tried to push the winning run across but Gina Schrader's throw was way ahead of Crouse and she was tagged out trying to get back to third.

Adelphi also had its scoring chances loading the bases in the top of the sixth after consecutive singles by Lori Mongillo and Ellen Spruce. After an intentional walk to Robin Bartholomew, Larsen got Coyne on a pop up to centerfield.

The two teams meet again on Saturday at 4PM and 6PM if needed. The winner will advance to the Women's College World Series to be played in Omaha, NE May 20-24. Freshman Debbie DeJohn (25-5) is scheduled to start against Julie Bolduc (11-4).
