TALLAHASSEE, FL-The Florida State Lady Seminole softball earned its first trip to the Women's College World Series defeating the Adelphi Panthers 3-1 in 13 innings Sunday afternoon at Lady Seminole Field taking the best of three regional playoff series in two games. The Lady Seminoles took a 1-0 decision in hine innings Friday night.

Florida State pushed across two runs in the top of the thirteenth inning when centerfielder Lynn Steele started off the inning at second in accordance with the International tie breaker rule. The rule had been in effect since the top of the tenth inning. After advancing to third base on a sacrifice bunt by pitcher Julie Larsen, Steele scored on a single to left field by designated player Debbie DeJohn. DeJohn, who provided the hit in both playoff games for FSU, began the game at pitcher. went the first innings giving up one unearned run while striking out two and walking one. DeJohn also scored an insurance run pring from third on a mishandled ball at first by Sheilagh Flanagan. Larsen, who worked the final five innings shut down Adelphi in the bottom of the thirteenth striking out two and getting pitcher Kris Peterson to ground out to second to end the game. Larsen, who got both playoff wins, raises her record to 25-7 on the year, while Peterson, who worked all 22 innings of the playoff drops to 20-7.
