

FSU third in softball

TAMPA — Florida State's women's softball team suffered its first loss of the season, finishing third at the University of South Florida Invitational held Friday through Sunday after winning two games and losing one.

Louisiana Tech finished first, followed by the University of South Carolina.

The Lady Seminoles, 16-1, defeated Oklahoma City 5-0, lost to South Carolina and the beat Central Michigan 6-2.

Tiffany Daniels was the All-Tournament Shortstop and also received the Highest Batting Average Award with .458.
