FLORIDA STATE SOFTBALL

FULLERTON, CA--In the midst of a four game losing skid, No. 9 Florida State lost to Northwestern, 8-2 and Cal. State-Fullerton, 7-0, in pool-play of the Pony Tournament Tuesday.

In the opener, Northwestern exploded for three runs in the first inning off starter Kristy Fuentes (7-1). After giving up a single and double to start the second, Fuentes gave way to Marla Looper as the Wildcats ended the inning with a 5-0 lead.

Shamalene Wilson put FSU on the board in the third when her two-out triple scored Laurie Shepard. An inning later Cindy Lawton brought the Seminoles to 5-2 when she cleared the left-field fence with her second round-tripper of the year. But, Florida State could get no closer as Looper gave up a two-run shot to Tricia Kay in the fifth. Lawton and Wilson both had two-hits apiece for Florida State.

Michele Hawkins (9-1) was in control all the way for Northwestern, holding FSU to five hits and striking out seven. The Wildcats roughed-up Seminole pitching for 12 hits to improve their record to 11-5.

In the second game, tournament host, 16th-ranked Cal. State-Fullerton pounded out 10 hits in cruising to the shutout victory. Florida State could not get on track offensively as Trinity Johnson (4-7) scattered five hits to pick up the win.

FSU was unable to advance a runner beyond second as starting pitcher Rebecca Aase, hitting for only the second game this season, was a perfect 3-for-3 at the plate. Unfortunately she was unable to carry her offensive fortunes to the mound, giving up four extra-base hits and uncorking three wild pitches. Her record falls to 11-4.

Florida State (30-9) concludes pool-play Wednesday against third-ranked SW Louisiana.
