#12 LADY SEMINOLES MAKE IT 10 IN A ROW

TALLAHASSEE - The 12th ranked Lady Seminole softball team improved its overall record to 15-3 and 4-0 in ACC play with a sweep (6-3, 3-1) of the North Carolina Tar Heels, Sunday afternoon at Lady Seminole Field. Today's two victories bring FSU's winning streak to 10 straight games, having last lost to number one-ranked Arizona back on Feb. 19. North Carolina falls to 7-5 on the season and 2-2 in league play.

The first game saw Florida State doing most of its damage early, knotting one run in both the first and second innings. The Lady Seminoles increased their lead with a four-run third, bringing the score to 6-0. But the Tar Heels came storming back in the next inning, scoring three runs of their own. But despite nine hits, North Carolina left eight runners stranded and failed to score another run. Florida State tallied 10 hits and was led by freshman right fielder Kristy Hull, who ripped three hits of her own. Six different players earned RBI's in the game for FSU as sophomore pitcher Kristy Fuentes earned her fifth victory of the young season.

Game two saw FSU pitcher Renee Espinoza allow just three Tar Heel hits. Trailing by one run in the top of the fourth, North Carolina tied the game. But FSU came back strong in its half of the inning, regaining the lead with a run, followed by another in the fifth. Espinoza improved her record to 8-2, but was backed up by solid offense as the Lady 'Noles tallied eight hits in the game. Senior Laurie Shepard and freshman Misty Molin each tallied two hits to lead the way in the game.

Florida State will host Marshall tomorrow, Monday, March 6 in a nonconference doubleheader beginning at 4:30 p.m. at Lady Seminole Field.
