SOFTBALL 'NOLES GO 2-1 IN FIRST DAY OF INVITATIONAL

TALLAHASSEE- The 9th-ranked Florida State Lady Seminole softball team improved its record to 28-6 overall as the Tribe went 2-1 in the first day of the Lady Seminole Invitational, hosted by Florida State University.

Florida State opened the day with a bang, scoring 14 runs off 13 hits in its first game, as the Tribe downed Samford, 14-0. The next game vs. Miami of Ohio was much of the same as FSU ripped 16 hits in defeating the Redskins, 9-1.

Florida State's last game of the day matched the Lady Seminoles with the 8th-ranked Michigan Wolverines. The entire game was close as the game was scoreless until the sixth inning when Michigan, the home team, scored a run. In the top of the seventh though, FSU responded when with two outs, freshman Misty Molin singled, scoring Cindy Lawton, who had three of FSU's hits in the game. But Michigan pulled out the 2-1 victory as the game went into the eighth and the tie-breaker rule went into effect.

Florida State will continue action tomorrow with an 11 a.m. game vs. Northern Illinois at Messer Field and a 3 p.m. game vs. Southwest Missouri State at Lady Seminole Field. The Invitational turns into a single-elimination tournament as the top two teams in the four pools advance to playoff action at 7:30 p.m. at Messer Field.
