1998 ATLANTIC COAST CONFERENCE SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

GAME EIGHT: CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

VENABLE PITCHES FLORIDA STATE TO ACC TITLE

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. -- Florida State junior pitcher Stacy Venable earned Most Valuable Player honors after she led Florida State to a 2-1 victory over Virginia in the 1998 Atlantic Coast Conference Softball Tournament championship game this afternoon at Lady Seminole Field.

Venable, who improved to 18-7 overall, recorded three victories in the tournament. The title marks the sixth ACC Tournament crown for No. 16-ranked Florida State, who improved to 50-18 with today's victory. Virginia falls to 38-28.

The game went scoreless until the 5th inning when FSU scored one run. With one out and one on, FSU's Tami Post reached base on an error by Virginia shortstop Lori Reese. Post later scored on a second Reese error. The Cavaliers, however, scored a run of their own in the top of the sixth. With one out, Reese singled to right field and was driven in by a single by Amy Peay.

The game was decided in the FSU sixth when with one out, the Lady Seminoles put together three straight base hits. A single by senior Kristy Hull scored Christy Cerecedes.

Aside from Venable, four other FSU players earned all-tournament team honors -- the most of any league team. Jesse McGregor, Kristy Hull, Dana Bailey and Corrie Williams were selected from FSU. The other team members included Lori Reese, Stacey Zagol and Meaghan Young from Virginia, Holly Meehan from Maryland, Lorin Slade from North Carolina and Lauren Webb from Georgia Tech.

Today's games marked the last action on Lady Seminole Field as Florida State will be playing at its new complex next season.

FSU has two regular-season games remaining. The Tribe will travel to Tampa for a doubleheader with rival-South Florida on May 6th.
