Florida State Head Coach Dr. JoAnne Graf

We had some lost opportunities early on and didn't score, but (pitcher) Leslie (Malerich) came up pretty big for us, and then we got a big hit from Kimmy (Carter) to score two runs.

On playing against Long Beach's tough defense

"We didn't set a specific number for what we needed to do. We have faith in our pitching and our defense, and we felt that we needed to score first to pressure them. We tried to score early and weren't successful, but then in the 6^{th} , Kimmy came up huge for us

Long Beach State Head Coach Pete Manarino:

The last three years, we've been a five seed, and we had an opportunity today being a three seed. You know that the 3/4 game is going to be a tough softball game. Give Florida State credit, they're a good team. This time of year, it's going to take a good effort to win. When you're in a tight game like this, you have to take advantage. Today, they found a way and we fell short.

On being the 3/4 seed and having to face UCLA tomorrow

Long Beach State pitcher Kristi Fox
