Florida State's Lady Seminole swimming team dropped its opening meet of the season Saturday to Indian River Community College, 84-47, under cold and rainy skies at FSU's Union Aquatic Center.

Scholarship-clad Indian River proved to be too powerful for Florida State's volunteer club as four of the visitors scored double victories to lead their team to a comfortable win.

The Seminoles were not without fine performances, though, as Jackie Walker and Sue Clark scored double victories. Walker dominated the distance competition taking the 200 and 400 yard freestyle events. Clark captured the 50-yard Fly and the 200 yard Individual Medley for the Seminoles.
