## Lady Tribe sinks UNC by 83-48

CHAPEL HILL, N.C. — Florida State's women's swim team picked up its first victory of the year with an 83-48 triumph over the University of North Carolina here Saturday afternoon.

The lady Seminoles finished first in 12 of 14 events en route to the upset victory. Florida State's Mary Montgomery finished first in three events, and ended the afternoon as the Seminole's leading scorer.

Montgomery, a freshman from North Carolina who was an American participant in the 1972 Olympics, had victories in the 200-yard individual medley, the 100-yard freestyle, and the 100-yard breaststroke.

Another Florida State freshman, Missy MacInnis, also had an outstanding showing in the 50-yard backstroke and became the eighth lady Seminole swimmer to qualify for the nationals. MacInnis finished with a time of 30.5 seconds in that event.

For the Florida State girls, it was their first victory of the season against three losses. North Carolina dropped its first meet of the year after six consecutive victories.
