

FSU swimmer sets new record

PITTSBURGH — Florida State's Lisa Nencioni set a new FSU record in the 100-yard individual medley here Saturday night in the AIAW National Swimming and Diving Championships.

Nencioni had a time of 1:00.34 and finished 20th in the event.

Florida State's 400-yard relay team of Lisa Davison, Kim Dunlop, Kathi Miller and Jeanne Dowdle was 16th with a time of 3:34.46. That finish gives the relay team all-American status.

Dunlop is a freshman and graduated from Godby High.
