FSU women swimmers end record season

NEW ORLEANS — The FSU women's swim team had a pair of triple winners and ended its record-setting regular season Saturday afternoon with a double-dual meet win against Alabama and Tulane.

The Lady Seminoles beat Alabama 80-60 and Tulane 87-27 to raise their record to 11-1, the best in FSU's history. The previous best had been a 10-2 mark.

FSU's Lenore Gribble won the 100-yard freestyle in 52.6 seconds, the 100-yd. butterfly in 58.1 and the 50-yd. free in 24.5. Lady Seminole junior Meg McCully touched first in the 50-yd. backstroke in 27.8, the 100-yd. back in 59.6 and the 200-yd. free in 1:53.8.

Next on the agenda for the FSU women are the Southern Intercollegiate Championships to be held in Athens, Ga. Feb. 14-16.
