## Lehner races to 3rd in swimming

FSU's Lehner swims to another third place

GAINESVILLE — Florida State swimmer Laurie Lehner placed third in the 100-yard butterfly with a time of 53.42 at the United States Short Course Championships.

Jill Sterkel, the current American record holder from the University of Texas, won the event in 53.20 and current world record holder Mary Meagher, representing Lakeside Aquatic Club, finished second in 53.22.

It was the second third-place finish for Lehner at the championships, as Friday she finished third in the 50-yard freestyle in a time of 22.87, becoming one of only three women in the world to break the 23-second barrier.

The FSU men's 400-yard medley relay team finished in 16th place overall with a time of 4:24.80.
