Three members of the FSU swim team qualified to compete in the 1993 NCAA Championships.

Ignacio Merino and Robert Braknis posted times that will send them to Indianapolis to compete in the men's field May 25-27. Merino, a sophomore, qualified in the 100 butterfly and the 200 breaststroke. Merino also will swim the 200 butterfly. Braknis, a freshman who holds school records in two events, will swim the 50 and 100 freestyle and 200 butterfly.
