KALAMAZOO, Mich. — Emily Waugh, formerly of Tallahassee and now with Duke University, joined Florida State's Sally Schweppe in the fourth round consolation of the Women's National Collegiate Tennis Tournament.

Waugh defeated Lisa Cult of Kalamazoo State 6-1, 6-3, but lost to Trinity's No. 4 seed Stephanie Tollison. Trinity's Joanne Russell, the tourney's No. 1 seed, sent Schweppe to the loser's bracket with a 6-1, 6-1 triumph.

FSU's Mary Ellen Wilkensen lost twice Tuesday and was eliminated from play, joining teammate Janet Haworth on the sidelines.

The doubles team of Haworth-Schweppe defeated Furman's team of Koster - Nicholson 6-2, 6-4, lost to Midland (Tex.) Jr. College's team of Lancaster-Regger 6-0, 6-3.

FSU pair, Waugh lose

KALAMAZOO, Mich. — Florida State's Janet Haworth and Sally Schweppe and former Tallahasseean Emily Waugh went down to defeat in consolation play in the Women's National Collegiate Tennis Tournament here Wednesday.

Schweppe defeated Kathy Muller of Trenton State 1-6, 6-1, 7-5 before losing to Barbara Hanburg 6-1, 6-2 of Odessa, Tex.

Waugh, now playing for Duke University, defeated Caroline Ishii of California 6-4, 6-3 before losing to Julia Kirkham of Princeton 6-2, 6-3.

FSU's doubles team of Schweppe-Haworth defeated the University of Minnesota's Ritter-Thomas team 6-2, 6-2 and then advanced another round in the consolation doubles by default. That team has now reached the quarterfinals.

The Seminoles' doubles team of Leah Homeyer and Mary Ellen Wilkinson was defeated by the University of California-Santa Barbara team of Blekmer-Elliott 1-6, 6-4, 7-5.
