

COLUMBUS, Miss. — South Florida's Judy Hanrahan and Jamie Baisden got through two rounds of singles and one of doubles here yesterday in the first of three days of action in the annual Southern Intercollegiate Tennis Championships on the campus of the Mississippi University for Women.

Miss Hanrahan, the top-seed, got a bye in the first round, then defeated Tommicile Dean of Mississippi, 6-0, 6-0, in the second round. She will meet Judy Gfroerer of the host school in today's match.

Miss Baisden, a freshman, bested Mitzi Minor of Auburn in the first round, 6-4, 6-0, then ousted Hunter Dortch of North Carolina, 6-2, 6-3, in the next round. She faces Phyllis Blackwell of UT-Chattanooga today.

Together the two are the No. 1 seeds in doubles and yesterday beat Sally Isbell and Angela Hurr of Tennessee, 6-0, 6-1, in the opening round.

In team scoring, UT-Chattanooga led with 7 points, Rollins College and Louisiana State had 6 each, the hosts had 5 and USF was tied with Florida State and SIU-Carbondale at 4.

"They looked very good playing doubles today," said USF's JoAnne Young, who accompanied the pair to the tourney. "They made very few errors and both are really playing good tennis."
