

'Noles 11th in Invitational

Florida State got off to a rough start Wednesday during the first day of the Lady Seminole Tennis Invitational tournament. FSU scored only one point, and is tied for 11th in the 18-team tournament.

The University of Florida and Rollins State are tied for first with eight points, while Trinity is third with seven. Texas State is fourth (six); South Florida fifth (five); and the University of North Carolina is sixth (4). Tied for seventh are Mississippi (2); Trenton (2); Auburn (2); and Duke (2). Tied for 11th are FSU and Tulane with one point each.

Play resumes at 9 a.m. today.

Florida netters lead Lady Seminole event

The University of Florida holds a four-point lead in the Lady Seminole Tennis Classic after two days action.

Florida's netters have 15 points, to 11 for Trinity and 10 for Rollins. Texas followed with 9, South Florida has 7, Mississippi University for Women 4 $\frac{1}{2}$, the University of North Carolina 4 $\frac{1}{2}$, Duke 3 $\frac{1}{2}$, and Auburn and home-standing Florida State 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ each.

The action will continue today and conclude on Saturday. All matches are being played at the Tully Gym and Alexander Gym courts.

Ann Smith of Trinity, ranked num-

ber one in singles, has advanced to the semifinals with a group of straight-set wins. The other semifinalists are Sherry Acker of Florida, Ann Etheridge of Mississippi University for Women and Julie Presley, also of Florida.
